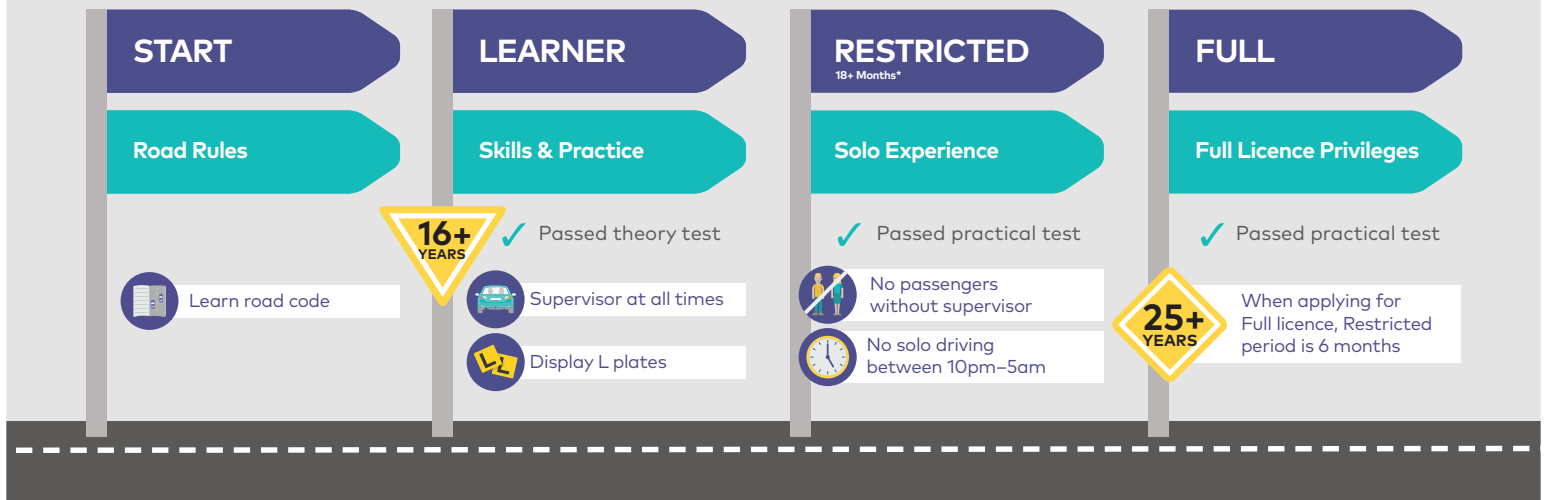


The roadmap to your car licence



Booking your learner licence test



Must be over 16 years. ID required.



Fill in application form (available at NZTA.govt.nz or testing agent)

Cost:

Application fee	\$48.20
Test fee	\$45.70
Total cost	\$93.90

ID required for booking



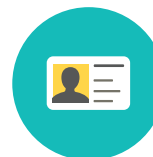
Current NZ Passport

- Overseas passport
- Original birth certificate

all times



Must display
L plates



Zero alcohol
for under 20s



Must have supervisor
(Full licence for 2 years)
with you at all times

build up practice



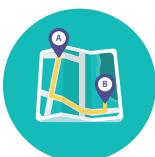
Practice in the safest
