

Buy a ı a book



Buy a road code from a bookshop or borrow one from the library



learners licence workshop



All questions based on road code

30 mins to complete

On test day



at least

10 mins before



Take photo ID

Computer test



Multi choice

Take glasses if you wear them



Must get 32 questions

right to pass

When you get your learner licence



Take your licence with you at all times



Must display L plates



Zero alcohol for under 20s



Must have supervisor (Full licence for 2 years) with you at all times

Seek help of a driving instructor if you can



Start out slow and build up practice



Plan lessons beforehand



Practice in the safest car possible



Don't make lessons too long



Expect mistakes, it's a part of learning



Aim for 120 hours practice before going for restricted
