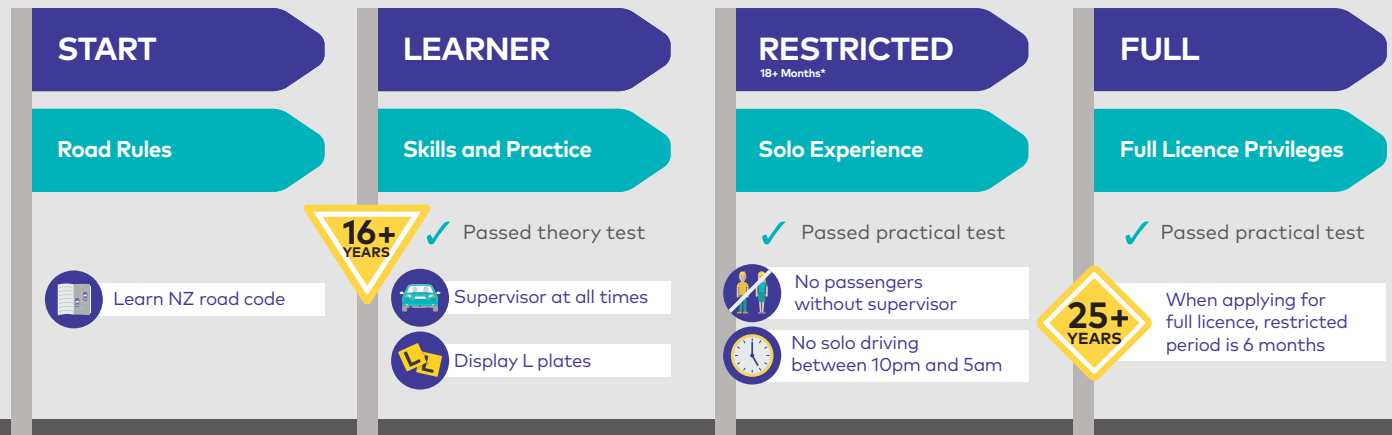


The roadmap to your vehicle licence

Must be over 16 years.
ID required



Fill in application form (available at nzta.govt.nz or testing agent)



Book at a testing agent in person



Photo taken when booking



Eyesight checked when booking

ID required for booking



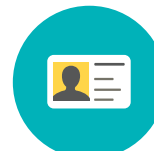
Current NZ passport

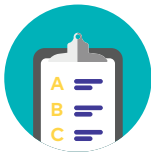
What happens in the test



30 minutes

Multi-choice



Must get 32 questions
right to pass



All questions based
on road code

On test day



Arrive early,
at least
10 minutes before



Take photo ID



Take glasses if you
wear them



Report and
wait inside

When you get your learner licence



Take your licence
with you at
all times



Must display
L plates



Zero alcohol
for under 20s



Must have supervisor
(full licence for 2 years)
with you at all times

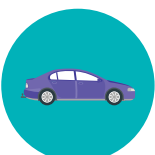
Now you have your learner licence – what next?
